Online Art Auction www:biddingforgood.com/cfaa

We are looking for artists that are interested in selling their art on our online auction website. This is how it works, you send us jpegs of three pieces of original artwork you would like to sell. We display and promote your artwork on the site, after the auction closes (usually about 4 weeks after it opens) the highest bidder for your art is awarded the work. The bidders payment is processed and the artist Receives 40% of the proceeds. CFAA takes 60% and pays the auction fees, promotional costs and shipping. The split works out to about 50/50 after all is said and done. You set the reserve on the piece so there isn't any chance of it selling for less that what you can live with. You (the artist) ship directly to the winning bidder after you have received your portion of the proceeds and CFAA will reimburse you for shipping costs. We will provide a contract to be signed by both parties.
